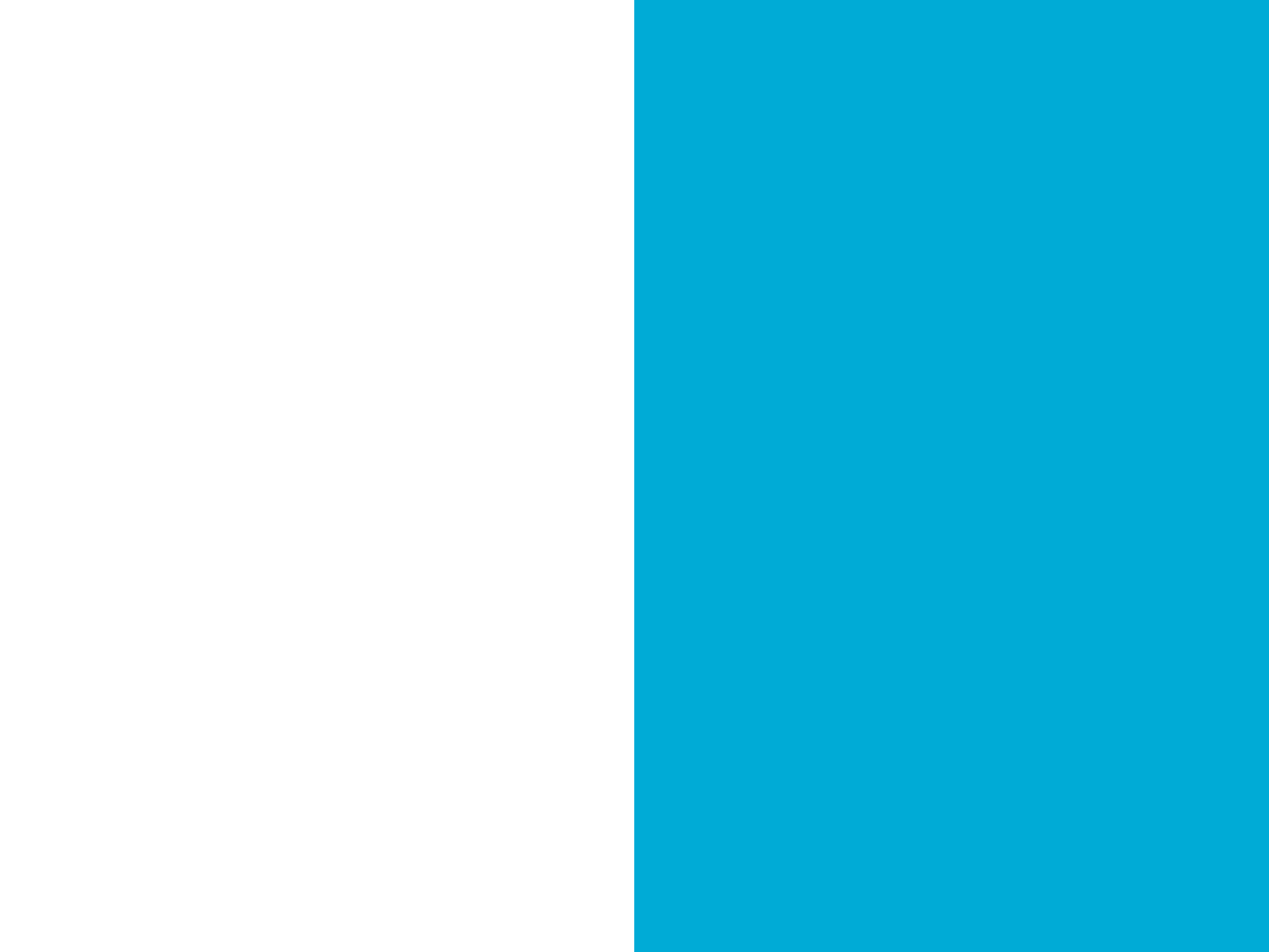

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT?

- ✓ During the implementation of the corporate program, the volume of APG flaring decreased more than tenfold.
- ✓ The Pyakyakhinskoye field (Yamalo-Nenets Autonomous District of Russia), commissioned in 2016, achieved zero APG flaring in a short period of time.
